INSTRUMENT OF DELEGATION

I, *THOMAS FISHER*, Federal Safety Commissioner, exercising my powers under subsection 32(1) of the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement Act 2005* ('the Act') to delegate all or any of my powers under the Act:

1. DELEGATE to the person for the time being occupying or performing the duties of the position of Deputy Secretary – Workplace Relations, of the Department of Employment and Workplace Relations all of my powers and functions as the accrediting authority for the accreditation scheme established by the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement (Accreditation Scheme) Regulations 2005* for the purpose of undertaking reviews of reviewable decisions under regulation 20 of the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement (Accreditation Scheme) Regulations 2005*;
2. SPECIFY that the Deputy Secretary – Workplace Relations, must not further delegate these powers and functions to another person; and
3. SPECIFY that this instrument has effect upon the date it is executed by me.
