



Highest Occurring CARs

- Mobile Plant: 14%
- Emergency Planning: 12%
- HIRAC: 10%
- The Scheme lost time injury frequency rate (LTIFR) for 2019 was <u>1.43</u>, continuing the downward trend over the past five years.
- The number of fatalities on Scheme accredited sites is trending down over the past four years.
- After 6 years of accreditation:
 - 67% of companies have reduced Workers
 Compensation Premium Rates by an average of 41%.
 - 67% of companies have reduced their Lost Time Injury Frequency Rates by an average of 89%.


