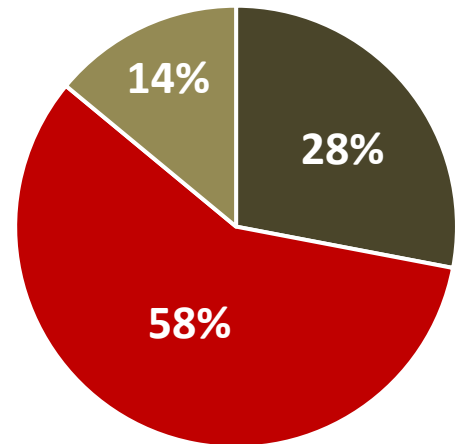

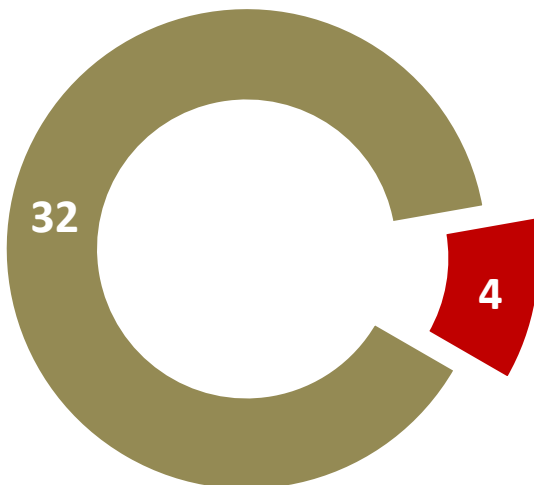

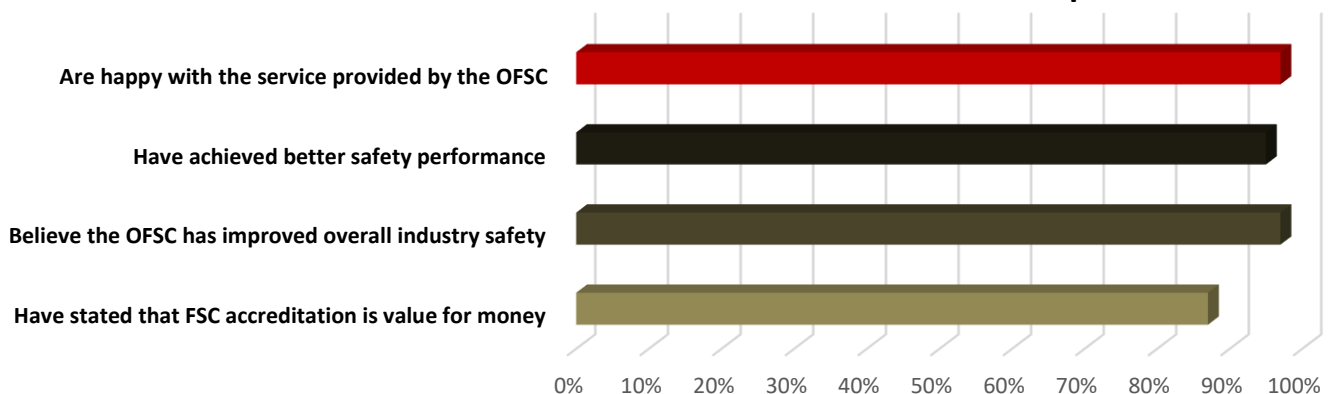

Highest Occurring CARs in 21/22FY

- Mobile Plant: 19%
- Emergency Planning: 10%
- Management of Subcontractor WHS: 8%

- The Scheme lost time injury frequency rate (LTIFR) for 2020 was **0.84**, continuing the downward trend over the past five years.
- The number of fatalities on Scheme accredited sites is trending down over the past four years.
- After 6 years of accreditation:
 - 66% of companies have reduced Workers Compensation Premium Rates by an average of 39%.
 - 70% of companies have reduced their Lost Time Injury Frequency Rates by an average of 87%.
