







Highest CAR Issue Rates by Head Criteria in 21/22FY

- WH14 -Health Surveillance and Exposure Monitoring: 39%
- FP1-Senior Management Commitment: 38%
- WH3- Legal Requirement: 37%
- The Scheme lost time injury frequency rate (LTIFR) for 2021 was 1.14, which sits as the second lowest in the past five years.
- The number of fatalities on Scheme accredited sites is trending down over the past four years.
- After 6 years of accreditation:
 - 65% of companies have reduced Workers Compensation Premium Rates by an average of 39%.
 - 66% of companies have reduced their Lost Time Injury Frequency Rates by an average of 88%.
